CONFINED SPACE ENTRY--TITLE 8 CCR 5156-5158

United's experienced and professional service crew is 40-hour HAZWOPER trained and certified in confined space entry and rescue procedures in accordance with OSHA Title 29 CFR 1910.120 and Title 8 CCR 5156-5158. In addition, all confined space rescue specialists have received annual first aid and CPR training. Prior to arriving onsite, a United Safety Officer will review the work plan and prepare written operating and rescue procedures to address the protocol that will be followed for the health and safety of all members working at the job site. At a minimum these procedures will include an approved site specific Health and Safety Plan and an approved Confined Space Entry Permit.

United also provides confined space rescue stand-by services for other entities. Due to the specific OSHA regulations for confined space rescue there is specialized equipment and training necessary to perform a safe and successful rescue. United ensures that:

- All personnel are trained to properly use the personal protective equipment and rescue equipment needed for confined space rescue.
- The rescue personnel have appropriate and approved respiratory protective equipment including an independent source of breathing air available for immediate use and fall protection equipment.
- Rescue personnel attend a refresher course to practice making confined space rescues at least once every 12 months.
- All personnel are made aware of the hazards they may face during a rescue effort.
